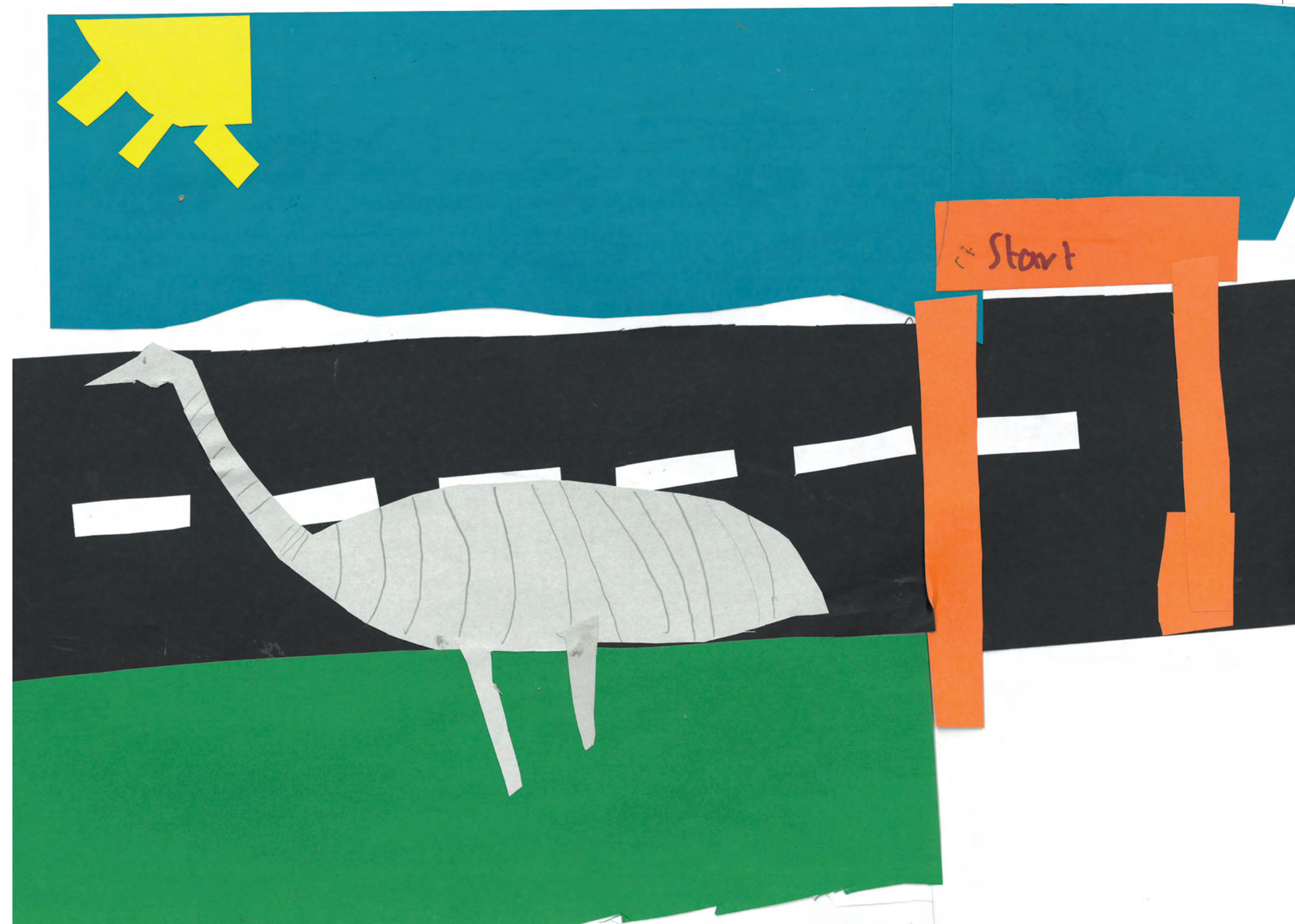
One day Murun the Emu getting water from the billabong and saying hello to Platypus.



She watched the butterflies dance in the breeze.



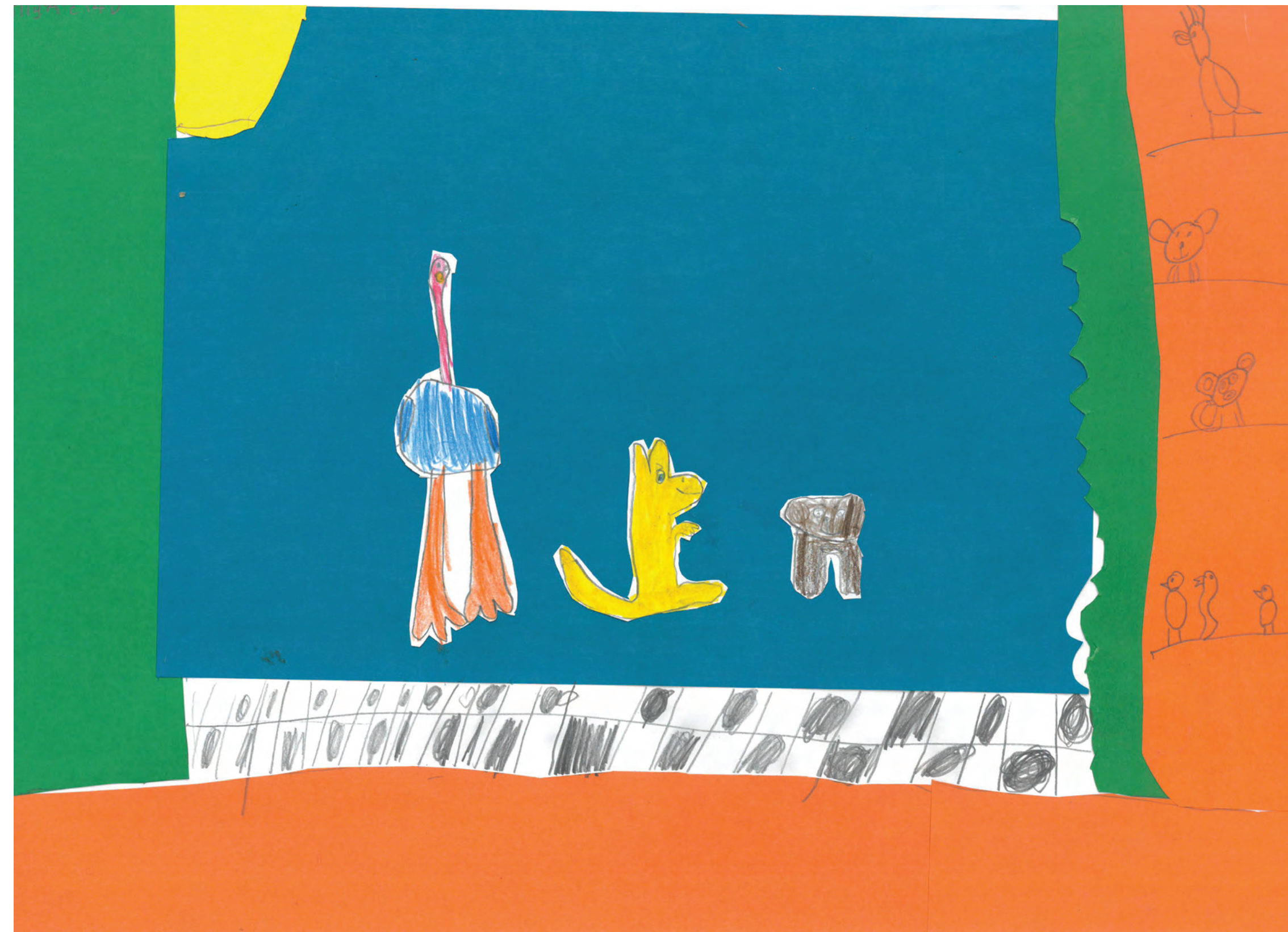
Murun thought she was going to enter a bush race. “I will win because I’m the fastest bird in Australia,” she said to herself.
